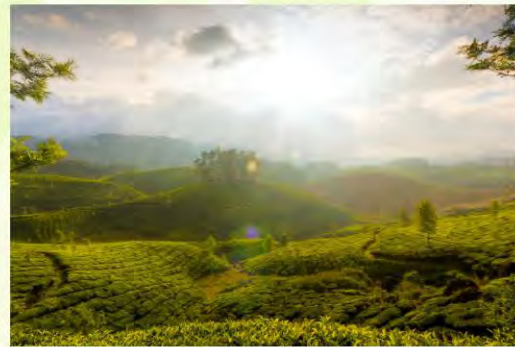

#### Bandipur

A haven for wildlife and natural beauty, Bandipur is an expansive sanctuary located just about 50 kms from Ooty. Once a private hunting reserve to the Maharaja of Mysore, Bandipur is now designated as a Tiger Reserve and shelters several other endangered species such as elephants, gaurs and pythons.



#### Munnar

At 5,200 ft above sea level, Munnar is one of India's largest tea-growing regions. Nestled in the embrace of the Western Ghats, this town has a landscape that is simply mesmerising. Located at a distance of about 240kms from Ooty, Munnar is a commercial hub that has also retained its cultural beauty.



#### Thekkady

Thekkady is a region synonymous with the Periyar National Park, Kerala. Located in Idukki district, the name conjures up sights of exotic wildlife, extensive spice plantations, and dense evergreen forests. Murikuddy, Anakkara and the Mangala Devi Temple are popular places of attraction in the region.



### Alleppey/Kumarakom

The seventh largest city in the state of Kerala, Alleppey is widely popular for its breathtaking backwaters and unmatched landscapes. The town connects Kumarakom and Cochin to the North and also plays host to the annual Boat Race that attracts millions of tourists world over.



### Kodaikanal

Literally translated as 'The Gift of the Forest', Kodaikanal is a city located about 250kms from Ooty. Set amidst hills, this town was recognized by the British as a getaway from the sweltering heat of tropical Indian cities. With rich culture and history, Kodaikanal offers tourists landscapes that are pristine, yet fascinating and refreshing.



### Wayanad

A district located on the southern tip of the Deccan Plateau, Wayanad is a popular tourist destination. Quaint and quiet, the district is housed by the expansive Western Ghats and boasts an altitude that ranges from 700 to 2100m. It is home to several indigenous tribes and is also known for its diverse culture and rich heritage.



### Kabini

Kabini, also known as the Kabini Forest Reserve, is a popular wildlife destination that borders the Mudumalai and Nagarhole National Parks. A region easily accessible and richly endowed, Kabini is home to various wildlife species including elephants and tigers. The Kabini Dam and River are beautiful landscapes that warrant a visit.
